Fishing Lakes

Wally's Lake is over 1.5 acres and is situated in a wooded valley and is the perfect place to unwind and enjoy the beauty of the area.

The lake is approached by foot only, through the riding stables and by following the track down the hill.

On arriving there are a variety of swims, the south side providing the deeper part of the lake whilst the island end providing shallower water ideal for surface fishing.

The lake provides coarse angling for all levels. Whether it's your first time fishing for Roach or you are a keen carper looking for your first 20 lb fish. Naturally stocked with specimen Carp to nearly 30 lb, specimen Bream over 13 lb, Roach and Skimmer Bream.

When fishing for Carp a 36" landing net and unhooking mat are required and we would suggest a minimum of 12 lb line. We do request that you have some knowledge and experience of fishing to ensure the health of our fish remain in good condition. Environmental licences required. Day tickets available at the camp shop and riding stables

How to get to Rosewall

Rosewall is 1/2 mile from the Osmington Mills turning off the A353. Approaching from Wareham on the A352, take the first exit on the Warmwell roundabout sign posted A353 Weymouth and Osmington. Nearing Osmington take the first turning left opposite the garage to Osmington Mills and follow the lane to Rosewall which is on the right just past the riding stables.

Camping

Our thirteen acre southerly camping field has spectacular views over Weymouth Bay, the venue for the 2012 Olympic sailing events, and the rolling hills of the surrounding Dorset countryside.

There are two modern toilet blocks both with showers, hair dryer points, shaver points and washing-up facilities. The lower block also has disabled facilities and a newly refurbished laundry room. There is a further separate laundry room next to the upper toilet block and shop, and a new play area for under 14's.

The camp shop operates seasonally and is well stocked with basic provisions as well as camping essentials including gas and freezer pack hire.

We are licensed for 225 tents and welcome families and couples only.

Whether you are first-timers or seasoned campers we are sure that you will find our park the perfect place to explore, not only the treasures and beauty of the immediate area, but the wealth of attractions and things to do only a short distance away.
